This coming year the exam will be given on February 27 & 28, 2024 and registration is currently open. The full detail are [here](#). This case-based, multiple-choice examination is intended to be used for self-evaluation and program improvement so that trainees know the areas in which they need to focus to strengthen their knowledge base. The 200-question exam is six hours long but given over two days so that trainees in the same program can alternate days. The exam is online, so it can be taken at a trainee's home institution. Reduced pricing is available for trainees who are ASCO members, as well as countries classified by the World Bank as low- and middle-income.
