ASCO's Medical Oncology In-Training Exam

A very popular resource for medical oncology training programs is our [Medical Oncology In-Training Exam \(ITE\)](#). This case-based, multiple-choice examination is intended to be used for self-evaluation and program improvement by identifying areas in which trainees should focus to strengthen their knowledge base. The 200-question exam is six hours long but given over two days so that trainees in the same program can alternate days. The exam is online, so it can be taken at a trainee's home institution.
